Static Display Update: We've had a number of inquiries about our Static Display Contest at Dayton Modelrama. Based on the questions we're getting; I wanted to get the information out there so that you can plan accordingly. The static display contest will take place during Dayton Modelrama April 25th and 26th.

This is what you need to know

• These are the Aircraft Categories -

- o Sport
- o Scale Military
- o Scale Civilian
- o Scale Jet
- Special Awards
 - o Best Junior Entry
 - o Best Boat
 - Special Recognition (this category can include cars / trucks etc.)
 - o Best of Show

All categories can be considered for **Best of Show** which is awarded \$250. All other categories will be awarded certificates; first through third.

To promote security, static display submissions will be guarded during the day, merchandise will be on tables with a rope surrounding the display. At night, the building will be closed and locked, an alarm system will be put into use. Also note, the Sheriff's Department has a sub station right off

fairgrounds entrance. The Dayton Wingmasters or Dayton Modelrama accepts no responsibility for lost or damage to entries.

- Entries can be accepted Friday April 25th from 7:00am to 3:00pm or Saturday 7:00am to 9:00am. When dropping off your plane, go to the Wingmasters Exhibition Hall and a sign will indicate where to drop your items off. Brett Becker is the CD for the contest, and he'll have paperwork that you'll need to compete.
- All items must be picked up by 3:00pm Saturday.
- There is no fee for putting your planes on display
- You can enter as many items as you want, however you can only have one item in each category.
